# Ultra Fast Fleece Scarves

# Ultra Fast Fleece Scarves

Here we go!

Cut 3 18" squares (could go as small as 16" if you want),

Fold the square in half vertically and then horizontally to form a 9" square,

Place the 16" donut template on the fabric so that the straight edges of the template are on the folded edges, and the curved edge is closest to the raw edges.

Cut along the curved edge.

Repeat for the other two 18" squares of fabric.

Now place the 6" donuts template on the 16" fabric circle and cut out the center of the circle, forming a "donut".

Leave your donut folded in half and use your scissors to cut along one of the folded edges to open the donut. (We will call this the "seam edge".)

Line up two donuts right sides together (RST) along the seam edge and stitch them together using your sewing machine or serger. (If using your serger be sure to leave a thread tail at the beginning and end. If using your sewing machine tie off at the beginning and the end.)

Repeat to attach to third donut

Thread the serger tails through a needle and "bury" the tails in the seam allowances.

If you do not have the donut template use your favorite method to cut the 16" outer circle and the 6" inner circle.
