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Quilted Look Coasters



General Supply List:

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Ruler

Scissors

Shears and Thread Snips

Iron and ironing surface

Fabric Marker of your choice (pen, pencil, chalk...)

Microtex size 80 or 90 needle or your favorite needle for embroidery.

Machine Feet

Regular Sewing

Construction Thread

General Sewing Supplies

Supply List for Quilted Look Coasters:

Project Supplies:

Front of Coaster: Four 5" squares of fabric, (I used 2 different fabrics.)

Back of Coaster: One 5" square of fabric

Inner Layer of flannel: One 5" square (optional)





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NOTE: These directions are to be used in conjunction with the videos.

Instructions:

Cut your fabric as listed on the supply list.

Fold all 4 of your top pieces in half and press (They are now 2 1/2" x 5")

Weave them together with the folded edges to the inside



Have the woven top facing right side up on your work area.

(There is really no right or wrong side, it is the same on both sides.)

Place the Coaster Back Fabric on top of the Coaster front (Right Sides Together)

Place the flannel on top of the coaster back fabric

Pin around all 4 edges

Stitch around all 4 edges using a 3/8" seam allowance

Trim your corners

Turn Right Side Out

Iron and Enjoy!
