Royal Baby Burp Cloth





Supply List:

- * Fabric for front
- * Coordinating Fabric for the Back

Equipment List:

- * Sewing Machine in good working order
- * Stitch in the ditch foot
- * General Sewing Supplies

Note:

These instructions are to be used in conjunction with the video for this class

Fabric	Quantity	size	prep
Front Fabric	1	13 1/2" wide. (13.5") 18 " long	Prewash
Choose ONE of the following sizes for your project			
Back Fabric with 2" band	1	13 1/2" wide. (13.5") 22 " long	Prewash
Back Fabric with 3" band	1	13 1/2" wide. (13.5" 24 " long	Prewash

Hint: If your print has a "directional print" be sure to hav it facing the correct direction.

FYI: Calculating the fabric needed for the "band at the bottom

Length of front fabric + width of desired band + width of desired band

Example 2" band:

Example 3" band:


Fabric Front = 18"
2" band (add 4")
Total Fabric Length = 22"

Fabric Front = 18"
3" band (add 6")
Total Fabric Length = 24"

Let's DO IT!!!


- 1. Place the fabrics RST with the sides and the bottom edges even.


 Note the top edges will not be even at this point.
- 2. If you are creating a **3**" band, draw a line **3**" from the bottom edge of the fabric If you are creating a **2**" band, draw a line **2**" from the bottom edge of the fabric
- 3. Use a Straight Stitch and stitch on the drawn line
- 4. Press your project following the information on the video




- 5. Mark a line on the back above the stitching line.

 If you are creating a **3**" band, draw a line **3**" above the line you just stitched If you are creating a **2**" band, draw a line **2**" above the line you just stitched
- 6. Fold on fold line and bring folded edged to cut edge of the project (Refer to video to see exactly how this is done.)





- 7. Pin in place and stitch using a 1/2" seam allowance on both sides and across the top, leaving a 5" opening at the top for turning.
- 8. To create an opening that gives you professional results, stitch according to the diagram below, and refer to the video



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- 9. Press your project.
- 10. Turn your project right sides out through the perfect opening you created, using the technique for perfect corners on the video, and just like magic you have a wonderful "band" of contrasting fabric at the bottom of your burp cloth.
- 10, Press the project again
- 11. Top stitch across the top of the burp cloth to close the opening.

 This could be done with a straight stitch or a decorative stitch
- 12. Add any other topstitching desired.
