## **Supply List:**

- Mylar Holiday Flourish embroidery design collection
- White Background Fabric- 1 3/4 yards
- Red Fabric- 1/3 yard
- Green Fabric (for Binding)- 1/3 yard
- Backing Fabric- 1 1/4 yards
- Batting- 40" x 42"
- Stabilizers: No Show Fusible Mesh and Medium Weight Tear Away
- Embroidery Threads for design
- Bobbin fill
- Color change chart for chosen designs
- 130mm x 180mm hoop (5" x 7")
- Sewing threads to match fabrics
- Blue water-erasable pen

# Holiday Flourish Tree Pattern

Before starting project, read the complete project instructions.

## Cutting Instructions:

### White Background Fabric

- 1 3/4 yards white background fabric cut into:
  - (5) 12" x 30" strips

### Red Fabric

- 1/3 yard red fabric cut into:
  - (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips for side border
  - (2) 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips for top/bottom border

### Green Fabric for Binding

- 1/3 yard red fabric cut into:
  - (4) 2 3/4" x WOF strips

### Backing Fabric

- (1)- 40" x 42"

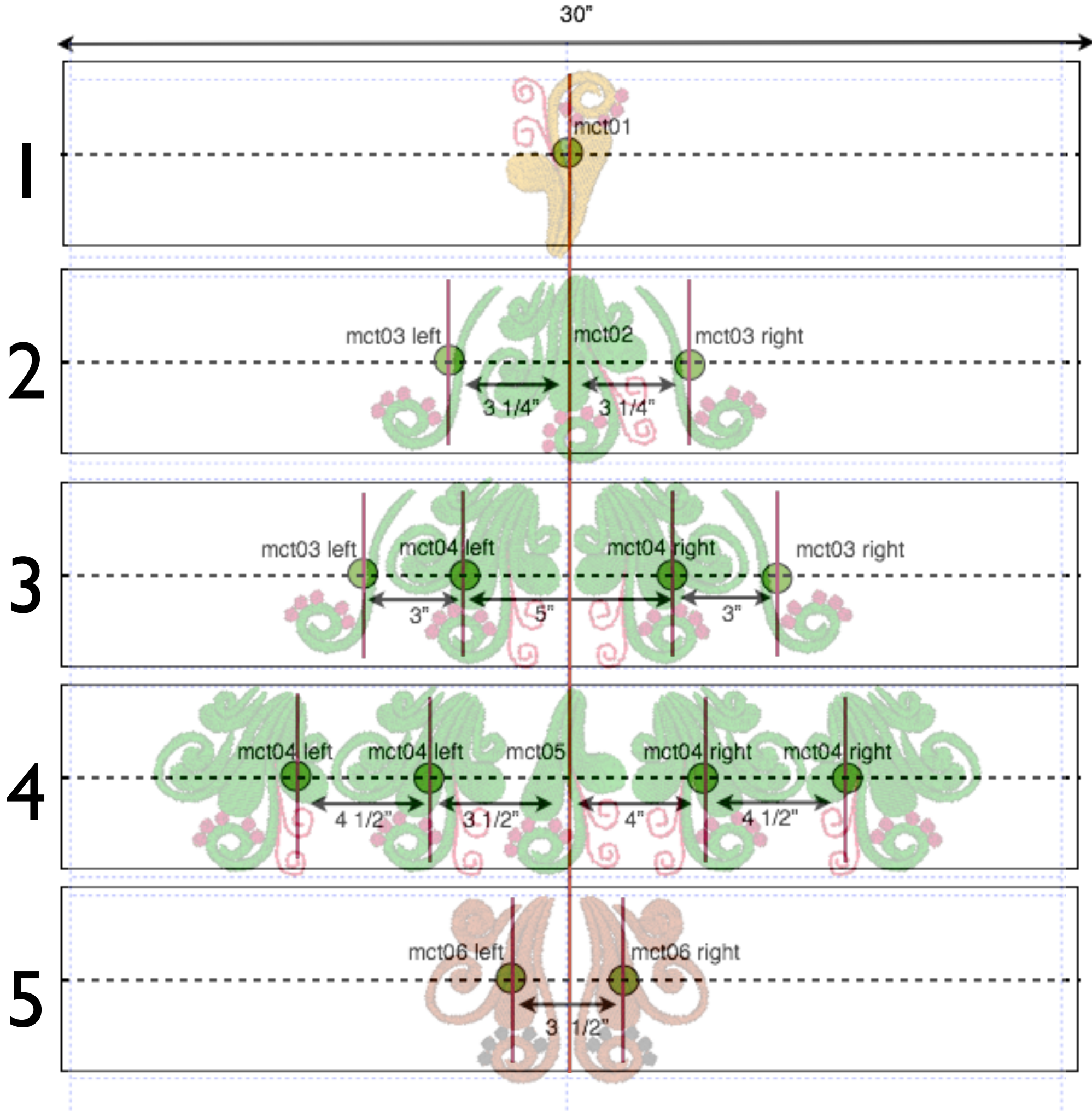
To prepare fabric for embroidery - fuse stabilizer to the back of the following:

- (5) -White 12" x 30"

Stabilizer suggestion- No Show Fusible ironed to the back of each block and slide a medium weight tearaway underneath hoop. If reading this document on a computer - click on this [link](#) to see a video on hooping embroidery. When each embroidery is complete, remove the excess tear-away only. Do not press embroidery after you remove it from the hoop. The No Show Fusible stabilizer will wrinkle if over-pressed. Any hoop marks and wrinkles will go away.



# Table Runner Layout



# Design Placement:

1. On each of (5) of the stabilized White background fabric 12" x 30" strips - draw a Line down the center vertically and horizontally using a blue water-erasable pen.

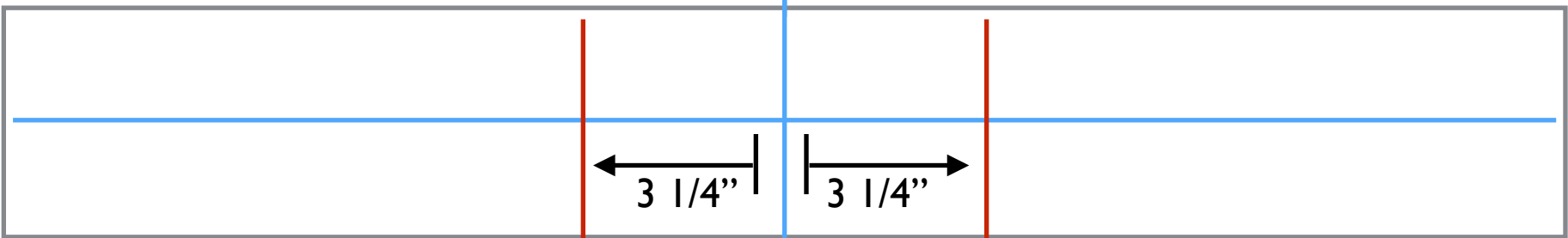


2. On each of the (5) stabilized White background fabric 12" x 30" strips - draw a **vertical line** at each of the distances in the diagrams below using a blue water-erasable pen. Label each strip as 1,2,3, etc.

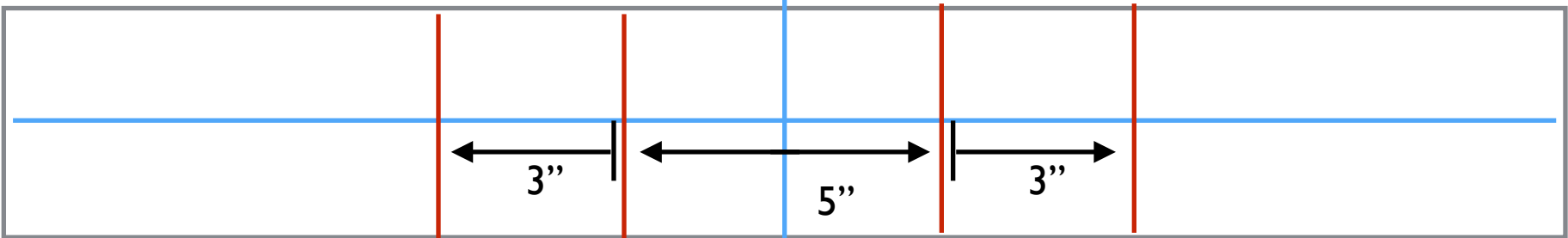

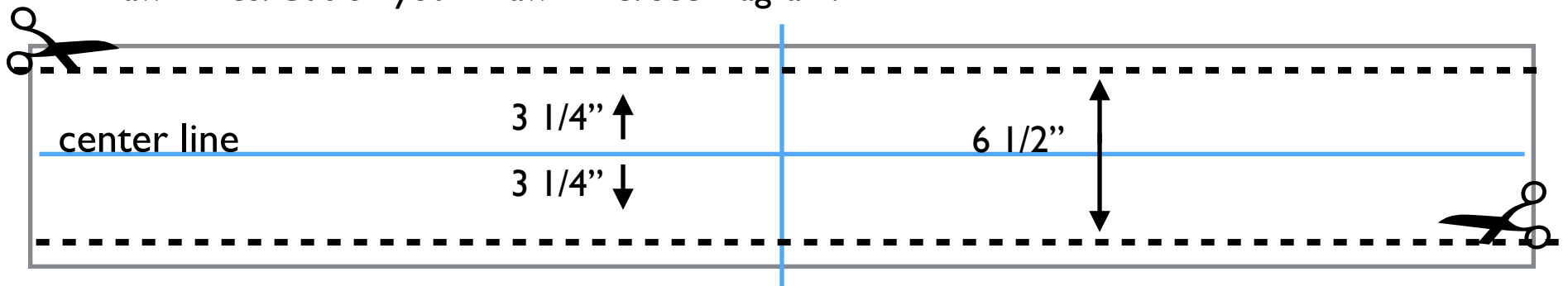
# Embroidery:

3. Each intersecting set of lines you marked in step 2 is marked with a circle below and are center placement lines for a design. The diagram below has each placement labelled with a design number. Embroider each design as indicated on the diagram below. Consult the color change chart to know when to lay down the mylar in each design and when to tear away the excess. When each design is complete, remove design from the hoop and remove the tear away from the back of the design. Continue to embroider until all strips are complete. Do not remove any blue placement markings. Do not press.

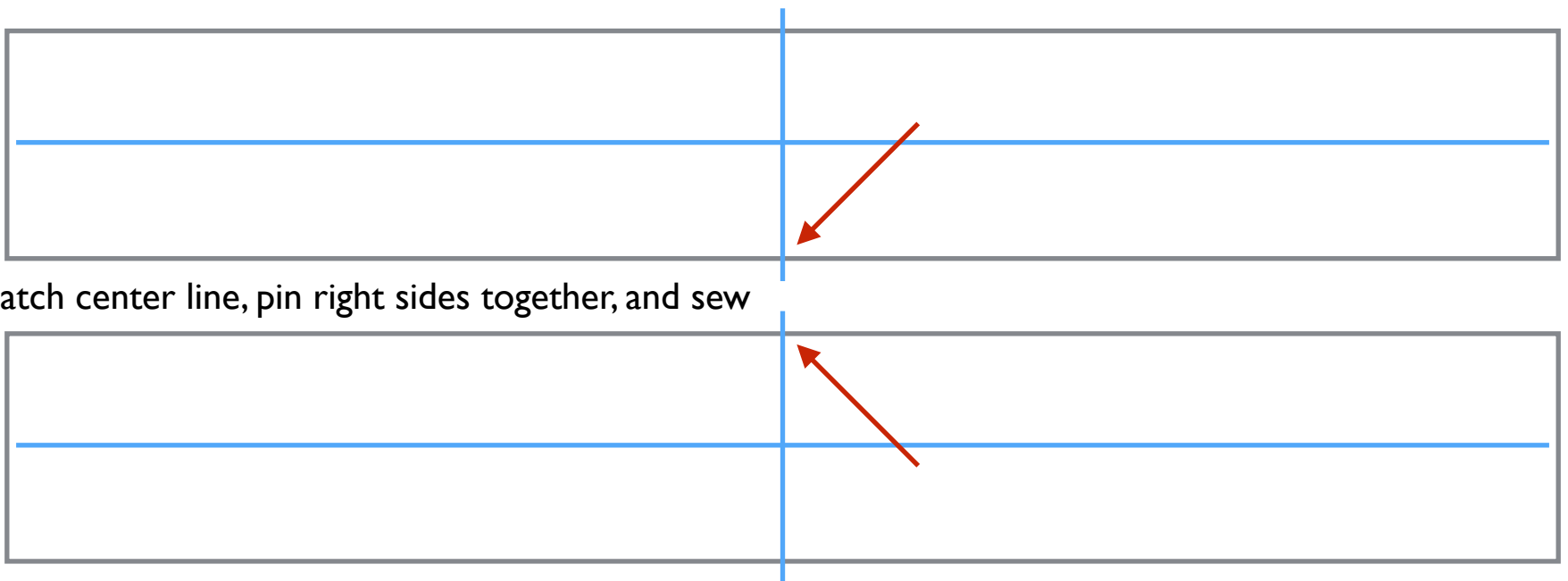
Use the Layout on pg. 2 as a guide



4. Trim each strip in width from **12** inches down to  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " inches. Do not trim the length of each. Measure out from the lengthwise center line  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " in both directions and draw a line for cutting. If your design placement was correct, all of your embroidery should be within these 2 drawn lines. Cut on your drawn line. See diagram.

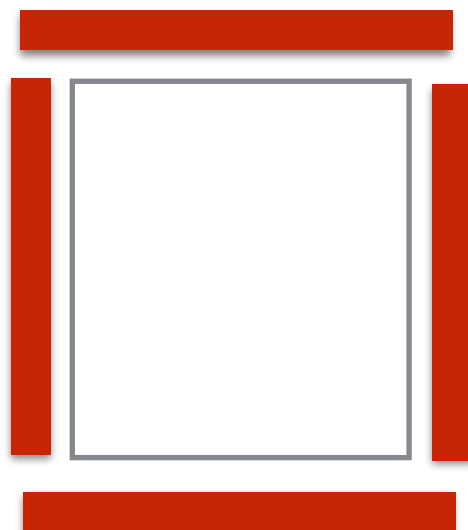


5. Now you will sew the strips together. Using a quarter inch seam allowance, match each strip's center placement line you drew in Step 1 and pin. Sew the strips together in numerical order until they are all sewn together as one piece and should equal a length of  $30\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press seams only.



Match center line, pin right sides together, and sew

6. Trim the width of this piece to  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " inches.  
 7. Sew one of the (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " red strips to each side. Press.  
 8. Sew one of the (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " red strips to each side. Press.





9. Layer quilt top, Batting and Backing and quilt with the method of your choice.
10. Take the (4) -  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inch strips and sew end to end with a mitered seam. Fold wrong sides together and press. Sew to top of quilted quilt, matching raw edges. Fold over to the back side and either hand sew the binding or stitch in the ditch.
