About Zentangle®

There are many Zentangle or "Tangle" patterns out for us to copy and share. Drawing them is simple, easy and fun if you follow the step outs. The patterns in this presentation are just a sampling of what is available to you. The pens you choose are up to you. I'm constantly looking for better pens, better colors, stronger nibs and ways make ZIAs (Zentangle Inspired Art) better.

The difference between Zentangle on Paper & Fabric

When tangling on paper, we often use a pen with a smaller nib, and a pencil & tortillion for shading and blending.


These are the pen I use on fabric.




Why Three Pens?

- The red FriXion pen is for the temporary lines, like those drawn with a pencil when on paper
- The dual tipped Identi pen has one small tip for drawing and a large tip for shading and filling large areas of color.
- The Grey Fabrico pen has two tips perfect for shading and replaces the pencil and tortillion.

Finally. . . Shade.







Let's try another. Start here with a grid.




Color the intersections




Finish with shading







This is one of my favorites!




By breaking the line, you create a "Sparkle"




Add echoed lines




Shading adds dimension







Circles make a great filler!




Add more circles!



Fill tiny spaces with tiny circles




Shade, Shade, and Blend!







Many designs are drawn on a grid.



Connect the small boxes as shown




Connect the boxes both horizontally and vertically



Draw perpendicular lines in each box



Finish with shading
