

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


Working With Templates

Computer Paper "Printable Sticky" Template


Each Template will have a horizontal and vertical center mark which we will use for placement

Be sure to mark the "top" of each design also.






Working with Templates Computer Paper

- Print everything out on sticky templates
- Using the combined template created with the computer paper arrange the sticky templates to actually create the design






Working with Templates

Printable Sticky Template


- 1. Center combined templates on fabric
- 2. Press in place
- 3. Mark the Center of the COMBINED design using the marks on the fabric
- 4. Mark the center for the design labeled #1 (the leaves)







Why remove the template?








- Put the template back on lining the template up with the stitched out design and the fabrics marks
- Make sure it lines up how you want it to
- Mark for design #2 (Applique' Flower)









Stitch out color 1
Place the fabric down
Stitch out color 2
Trim away excess fabric



Working with Templates



ENJOY THE PROCESS!

This design is a great design to build confidence for multi-hooping projects

- Continue stitching the designs
- Line up the template each time
- If corrections are needed, rearrange the template so it matches the stitch out and then make any changes necessary




Wet the fabric and fan fold

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Textured and deco stitches













Create the background of your choice with decorative stitches This eliminates the "What do I put in the center of this great design?" question!















Don't cut too close the fabric is sheer and it might pull away and leave a hole










Sheer Reverse Appliqué in the Hoop


Cut through linen and Sticky

Soluble






