How do 'in the hoop' quilts work?

- Step by step instructions buy designs with photos or graphics detailing each step
- Color stops
- Piece fabrics 'in the hoop'
- Batting is stitched 'in the hoop'
- Backing may also be stitched 'in the hoop'
- Once completed, embroidered blocks are stitched together, bias strips cover the joins in the back, binding is sewn on.

They're easy as pie!


Let's walk through the steps of an 'in the hoop' quilt block. This quilt design is called Kite Quilt.

Note that these instructions are Condensed to fit in the webinar timeframe!




Hoop stabilizer only, load design


Sew stitch sequence 1 to create a placement line on the stabilizer



 Center a piece of batting over the placement line. Tape in place.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 2 to tack dow the batting.




 Remove the hoop from the machine and trim around the stitch line with Pickle Pie's Duckbill Applique Scissors







 Sew Stitch Sequence 3 to stitch a kite-shaped
 placement line for Fabric A.




 Center the fabric over the placement line, right side up.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 4 to tack down the fabric.




Trim the diagonal seams to
 ½" seam allowance.




 Place Fabric B, right side down, over the lower diagonal seam of Fabric A.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 5 to tack down the fabric.




 Fold Fabric B down, so it is now right side up. Tape.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 6 to tack down Fabric B.




 Place Fabric C, right side down, aligning it with the upper diagonal seam of Fabric A.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 7 to tack down Fabric C.




 Fold Fabric C down, so it is now right side up. Tape.




 Sew Stitch Sequence 8 to tack down Fabric C.



 Remove the hoop and turn it over to the back. Center
 Fabric D over the outer
 placement line. Tape.




Return the hoop to your
machine and sew Stitch
Sequence 9 to create the
quilting stitches on Fabric A.



 Sew Stitch Sequence 9 to create quilting stitches on Fabrics B and C.




 Remove the project from the hoop and cut the block to square it up.




Stitch 24 blocks total for your wall hanging.


• To create the stars, pair up 4 blocks.



Repeat with remaining blocks.



 Place fusible seam tape on the bias tape, then cover the seams on the back of the quilt.



Continue with the instructions to learn how to bind your quilt.

White background, solid kite




Opposing background, print kite



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

Whimsical Applique Quilt Block projects

Let's look at how it's done...



Sew Stitch Sequence 1 directly on your stabilizer to create a placement line for your batting.




Center Batting over the placement line.

Sew Stitch Sequence 2 to create a cutting line on the batting.



Trim the batting with Pickle Pie's Duckbill Applique Scissors.






Center fabric over batting.



Sew the next stitch Sequence to stitch the quilting stitches.



Sew the next stitch sequence to stitch placement line.



Center fabric over the placement line.

Sew the next stitch Sequence to create a cutting line.



Trim the applique with Pickle Pie's Machine Embroidery scissors.



Next stitch sequence – Zigzag stitches.



Next stitch sequence – satin stitches.



Next stitch sequence – candle.



Next stitch sequence – flame.



Next stitch sequence – placement line.



Center fabric over the placement line.

Sew the next stitch Sequence to create a cutting line.



Trim the applique with Machine embroidery scissors.



Next two stitch sequences – zigzag and satin stitches.



For a quilt project, square up the block to the correct finished size.



Refer to 1 of 7 included Project Guides (included with the full Quilt Block Projects sets) to turn your block into a completed project in the same hooping...

- 1. Three Block Wall Hanging
- 2. Two Block Wall Hanging
- 3. Single Block Wall Hanging
- 4. Hot Pad
- 5. Mug Rug
- 6. Coaster
- 7. Pin Cushion




The Project Guide will give you any additional supplies and prep needed for your project.


Let's make a Mug Rug!




Using a ruler and pen, measure down 2" from the top left stitch line. Mark this outside the left stitch line as indicated by the arrow in the picture.




Repeat on the right side of the project.




Place prepared fabric over the top of the project. Align the fold of the fabric across the placement lines.




Place the next piece of fabric, overlapping the first.




Sew the final stitch sequence.



Remove the project from the hoop. Trim to a ½" seam allowance.



Turn right side out and press.



You're done!




